# Old Business

- Artificial Turf—Options presented by Clerk Buechter for batting cage.
  - o Alderman Sherrell moved to have Clerk Buechter purchase the artificial (Riviera Monterey-50) turf from Menards for the batting cage. Alderman Helton 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried unanimously. Alderman instructed Clerk Buechter to order a metal sign for the batting cage stating no cleats in the batting cage to preserve the integrity of the turf.
